ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF GUESTS

Vickie Peal, Team Manager for Storm Rugby, is requesting 6 light poles with lighting for night rugby games. They are a nonprofit organization and rely heavily on donations. The Mayor and Board of Alderman will get back with her concerning this request.

Mr. and Mrs. Ed Braley are requesting a 15 mph speed limit sign on Michelle Cove, Brighton, TN. They are currently having an issue with drivers speeding in the cove. Alderwoman Sartain made a motion to accept the 15mph speed zone for Michelle Cove, Brighton, TN. Alderwoman Washam seconded the motion. All approved. Motion carried. Mr. Matallee Hall, Public Works Director, will get the new sign erected.

Mr. John Mullins, 538 Bloomington Dr, Brighton, TN, has a concern about the drainage. The drainage pipe is causing sinkholes in his yard. Shane Greer, 68 Woodshire, Brighton, TN, also has issues with the drainage. He said "it looks the pipe underground has rusted out and the earth is just caving in". The Mayor and Board of Alderman stated that are getting bids to correct some of these issues.
