**Brighton Dixie Youth Baseball**

Ron Brimer, President of the Brighton Dixie Youth, stated that they have currently registered 134 children to play summer baseball. They will have another registration this weekend. Opening Ceremonies are scheduled for Saturday, April 4<sup>th</sup>.

To date, there are 12 vendors signed up for their Spring Bazaar. He suggested that we schedule the playground dedication to coincide with their Spring Bazaar.

Brighton will be hosting the 9-10 year old AAA District Tournament. The District Tournament will be held the last weekend of July.

Dixie Youth Baseball League requires all umpires to be certified to officiate tournaments. We will need to get at least 4 umpires certified by May 1<sup>st</sup>. Umpires will be responsible for the certification fee. The City of Munford will be sending their own certified umpires to officiate the older leagues. Those umpires will be paid through the Town of Brighton. All umpires and concession stand workers will need to complete a 2015 W-4 form for payroll.

Background checks will need to be completed for all coaches.

Before insurance can be obtained for the baseball league, Ms. Melissa Sartain will need to know how many teams are in each league. She will get that information to our insurance carrier.

Ms. Sarah Crocker made a motion to have a dedication for the playground equipment on Saturday, April 18, 2015. Ms. Melissa Sartain seconded the motion. All approved. Motion carried.

Brighton Sports Association – Basketball will be having an end of the year tournament through March 7, 2015. The Board also discussed making repairs to the old Brighton High Gymnasium roof and updating restroom facilities.

Brighton AYSO - Due to the inclement weather, one registration has been canceled. New registration dates will be announced soon. They will be having player evaluations on Saturday, February 28<sup>th</sup>.

The date for the 2015 Founder's Day is tentatively set for September 12, 2015. There will only be two events this year, the 5K and the Donkey Basketball.
